



PLANTS FOR POLLINATORS

Choose plants for bees, butterflies, moths, and hummingbirds. Support the life cycle of butterflies and moths by choosing host plants too.

We carry a good selection of pesticide-free native milkweeds to support Monarch butterflies, as many 7 different species during the growing season.

- Blue mistflower (*Conoclinium coelestinum*) - butterflies
- *Coreopsis* - bees, butterflies, and more

- Blanket flower (*Gaillardia*) - bees, butterflies
- Sunflower (*Helianthus*) - bees, butterflies, host

- Blazingstar (*Liatris spicata*) - bees, butterflies

- Beardtongue (*Penstemon digitalis*) - bees

- Gray-head coneflower (*Ratibida pinnata*) - bees
- Black-eyed Susan (*Rudbeckia*) - bees, butterflies
- Scarlet sage (*Salvia coccinea*) - butterflies, hummingbirds
- Clumping goldenrod (*Solidago*) - bees, butterflies, host
- Aster (*Symphotrichum*) - bees, butterflies, host
- Golden Alexander (*Zizia aurea*) - bees, host

Shrubs, Trees, Vines

- Maple (*Acer rubrum*) - bees, host
- Oak (*Quercus*) - host
- Red buckeye (*Aesculus pavia*) - bees, hummingbirds
- Bottlebrush buckeye (*A. parviflora*) - bees, butterflies
- Blueberry (*Vaccinium*) - bees, host
- Beautyberry (*Callicarpa americana*) - bees
- Buttonbush (*Cephalanthus occidentalis*) - bees, butterflies
- Redbud (*Cercis canadensis*) - bees, host
- Oakleaf hydrangea - bees
- St. John's wort (*Hypericum frondosum*) - bees
- Holly (*Ilex*) - bees
- Virginia sweetspire (*Itea virginica*) - bees
- Tulip tree (*Liriodendron tulipifera*) - bees, host
- Plum (*Prunus*) - bees, host
- *Viburnum* - bees, butterflies, host

To support pollinators across all seasons, choose some plants that bloom in the spring, some that bloom in the summer, and some that bloom in the fall.

Ask about our bird plants too - make your garden a wildlife oasis.
